### What's Happening?

#### **Day Away – Tomorrow!**

On Tuesday, June 5, staff members and parent chaperones will supervise students as they travel to various locations and participate in special activities throughout the day. The 7/8 students, heading to Great America, should be at school by 7:55 AM and meet in the Multi-Purpose Room; their bus will leave promptly at 8:10 AM.
